

EU GDPR COMPLIANCE CHECKLIST

COUNTDOWN TO 25 MAY 2018

Designate the necessary IT representative to ensure compliance by the deadline.

GDPR APPLIES TO ALL

The GDPR applies to all companies worldwide that process personal data of EU residents, regardless of their citizenship.

"PERSONAL DATA" REDEFINED

For the first time, personal data includes genetic, mental, cultural, economic and social information.

CONSENT

Without valid consent by an individual to access data, any personal data processing activities will be shut down by the authorities.

"THE RIGHT TO BE FORGOTTEN"

Organizations must have processes in place to delete data in response to an individual's requests. Data cannot be held any longer than needed.

PRIVACY IMPACT ASSESSMENTS

A DPO (a 3rd party is permitted) is to be appointed to ensure regular and systematic data monitoring.

DATA PROTECTION OFFICERS

In the event of a breach, an organization must notify the local data authority within 72 hours.

BREACH NOTIFICATIONS REQUIRED

All software will be required to be capable of completely erasing data.

PRIVACY BY DESIGN

An organization will only deal with one supervisory authority rather than a different one of each EU state.
